Position Summary:

The Intervention Program Specialist (IPS) collaborates with community partners to develop, implement, deliver and evaluate diversion programming for juvenile offenders, at-risk juveniles, truant students and their parents/guardians.

The Intervention Program goals include: reducing the rate and advancement of youth in the juvenile justice system; preventing and reducing youth substance use; repairing harm to victims; and decreasing the prevalence of risk factors that can lead youth to make poor choices by connecting them to supportive services for mental health concerns, family conflict or other issues.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Criminal Justice, Education, Psychology or other human service related field required
- Excellent oral and written communication skills
- The ability to build and maintain productive collaborative partnerships with multiple agencies, schools and families
- Prefer candidates with two or more years of experience in the delivery of case management, restorative justice and/or diversion practices

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Deliver case management and other programming to juveniles and their parents/guardians who are referred to BASC for diversion programming by the Beltrami County Attorney's office.
- Coordinate and facilitate restorative justice practices such as alternative responses to court, alternative responses to suspension, and client and family-centered practices.

- Facilitate, coordinate and represent BASC at meetings and working groups that address issues related to the Intervention Program goals.
- Engage with other agencies and schools to develop new intervention and prevention programming, practices, processes and systems changes.
- Write evaluation plans for the Intervention Program. Maintain and report on program evaluation data as required by BASC and/or program funding sources.
- Assist BASC Executive Director in developing, managing and monitoring Intervention Program budget.
